

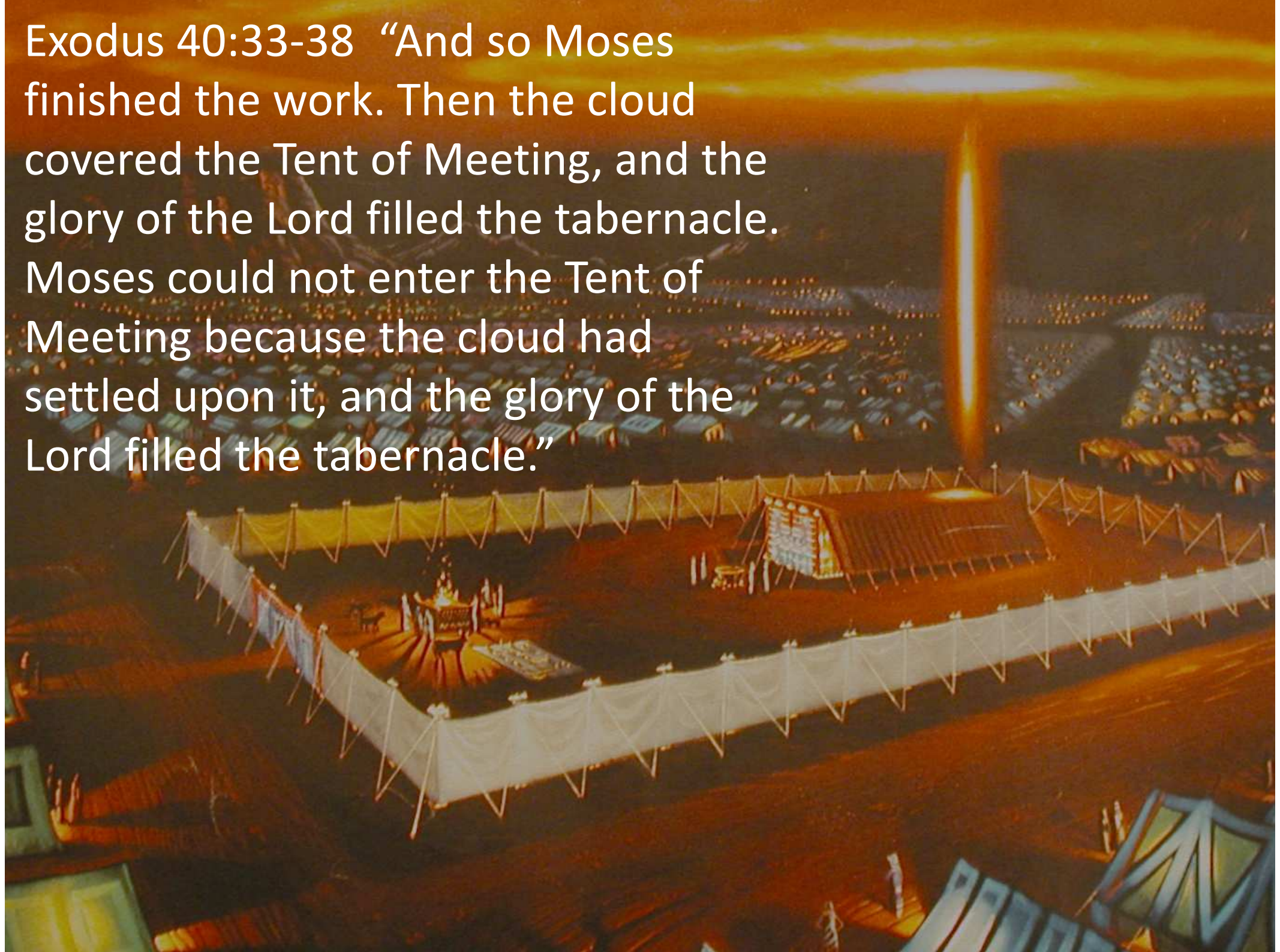

Solomon's Temple

1 Kings 8:10, 9:3 “When the priests withdrew from the Holy Place, the cloud filled the temple of the LORD. John 1:14 “The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.”

2 Cor 6:16 “For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: “I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.”

Conviction of Righteousness

Galatians 3:5,13

Gal 3:5 Does God give you his Spirit and work miracles among you because you observe the law, or because you believe what you heard? Consider Abraham: “He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.” ...Christ ...redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

Ez 43 “¹ I saw the glory of the God of Israel coming from the east. His voice was like the roar of rushing waters, and the land was radiant with his glory. ⁴ The glory of the LORD entered the temple through the gate facing east. ⁵ Then the Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple.
